When will the selected work be displayed?

December 2021

Do I have to be an SF Camerawork member to submit?

You do not have to be a current SF Camerawork member to submit. Your \$35 submission fee to Forecast 2021 will include a complimentary membership to SF Camerawork.

I am already an SF Camerawork member, how can I submit without paying?

Fees are waived for current SF Camerawork members. You will see the phrase "Your submission is free" on the upper-right of the screen on the last step to submit. Discounts are applied to the email associated with your SF Camerawork membership. If you have any questions regarding your membership or the discount, please contact info@sfcamerawork.org.

Can I submit old work?

Yes, you are welcome to submit old work.

Can I submit more than one body of work?

We do not recommend that you submit more than one body of work.

How many images can I submit and what's the max file size?

You can submit up to 10 images. Accepted file types are jpegs or pngs with a minimum 1200 pixels on the longest side and no more than 10 MB.

Can I submit a video?

You can submit one time-based work no longer than 15 minutes. The LensCulture submission portal will ask for a link to Vimeo or Youtube.

Can I go back in and make adjustments to my entry before the deadline?

You can edit your entry up until the submission deadline.
